Putting ACT on the map

Asset Mapping

- **Goal:** Identify who in Canada has KM and trial expertise
- **Output:** Showcase the breadth of expertise within and beyond ACT that ACT trialists can approach

KM Awards

- **Goal:** Incentivize KM activities
- 5-10k awards to support KM initiatives within ACT-funded RFPs

Case studies

- **Goal:** Collate a suite of case studies to exemplify diversity of ways in which ACT trial teams across the networks have engaged in KM across different types of trials
- **Output:** report exemplifying range of KM across ACT + disseminated on ACT website

Webinar Series

- **Goal:** Establish a short instructive webinar series outlining aspects of KM relevant to trials
- **Output:** live and website-posted KM short seminar series; to complement existing ACT webinars

Putting ACT 'on the map'

- Goal: Partner with ACT comms team to outline key achievements of ACT, where CTUs and adjacent networks are based, advancements made in Canada to accelerate future trials
- Output: Visualize who and where ACT-related sites and ACT-sponsored networks are located, activities are happening and have a clear idea externally of what and who ACT is
